

Campus Ambassador Job Description

A Coaching4Change (C4C) Campus Ambassador, represents C4C in a positive light, helping to increase brand awareness and recruitment efforts. Ambassadors are meant to embody the organization's mission and values.

C4C Campus Ambassadors will spend the majority of their time interacting with college students and faculty on their college campuses. Your primary task is to ensure that Coaching4Change is consistently displayed and accessible at your school. The Campus Ambassador role requires you to attend various social events, such as tabling events, classroom presentations, and other social gatherings at your school. In this role, you will report to a College Recruiter. This job description reflects the position for the 24'-25' school year.

As a C4C Campus Brand Ambassador, you will:

- Present Coaching4Change pitch to campus classrooms
- Communicate with campus Professors, Staff, and Leaders
- Connect with and present to Campus Clubs and Organizations
- Host tabling events on campus to promote Coaching4Change
- Attend scheduled campus events (ex. career fairs)
- Interview other mentors & record their mentoring experiences
- Support Coaching4Change Events
- Work with supervisor and other Campus Ambassadors to develop ways to accomplish goals best
- Attend regular check-in meetings with supervisor

- Experience and desire to build strong team culture
- Organized, Self-motivated, Creative Problem-Solver, High-Energy
- Prompt communication skills
- Possesses solid presentation & leadership skills
